RN/Physician Job Description

About ADTC:

American Dance Training Camp (ADTC) is a sleep-away dance camp, focused on hip-hop, jazz, lyrical, musical theatre and ballet for 8-17-year-old girls. ADTC has two great locations: Stratton Mountain, VT and Squaw Valley, CA. Our east coast home is the Stratton Mountain School in the picturesque Green Mountains of Southern Vermont. West coast campers stay at the Squaw Valley Academy nestled in a valley at the edge of Lake Tahoe. Both schools are fully-accredited and minutes from renowned mountain destination resorts. Each week-long session incorporates dance training with traditional summer camp activities like arts & crafts, swimming, hiking, horseback riding, canoeing / kayaking, organized team sports and several field trips.

Medical Responsibilities:

- Responsible for checking in on ill or injured campers and staff during daily visitation
- Review daily health logs to make sure camper (and staff) prescription medications have been administered as directed
- Assess campers and staff who are ill or injured and determine if further medical attention is needed.
- Direct staff as to when it is necessary to contact parents of ill or injured campers (if appropriate) and update them as necessary
- Review documentation of all injuries and care rendered. This involves documentation of all over-the-counter medicines, first aid treatment, communication with parents, doctors or any other off-camp facilities.
- Health Screening During Sunday “Check-in” for each session (12:30pm – 2:30pm)
- Remain “on-call” at night (when MVMC is closed) and available to assist ADTC in a medical emergency

Requirements:

Must be licensed (or temporarily licensed) as RN or physician in state camp is held

Must be 21 or older

Must have a valid driver's license and a clean driving record

RN Compensation:

\$500 per session (plus free meals when at camp) OR

\$250 per session plus FREE tuition for one camper (plus free meals when at camp)

The ADTC Tradition
