



## Certified Professional Choreographer

**Title:** Certified Professional Choreographer (CPC)

**Purpose:** To independently choreograph and teach master classes, camps and events throughout the US & abroad "as-needed" by ADTC and when your schedule allows. To partner with ADTC to market your local workshops, performances & events through our website, blog, social networking sites and newsletters.

**Essential Functions:** Plan, coordinate and independently teach your choreography at ADTC classes, camps & events.

- Travel to dance studios as needed/as available representing American Dance Training Camps and teaching private, highly customized weekend (one, two or three-day) and week-long (Monday - Friday) dance camps in your dance specialties.
- Actively help market yourself and your camps/events through the ADTC website, blog & Facebook page!

### Qualifications:

- Must be 21 or older.
- Must have a valid driver's license and a clean driving record.
- Bachelor's Degree Preferred.
- Successful completion of criminal background checks process.
- Non-US Citizens MUST have US work visa (J-1) as a condition of employment.

### Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Must be a talented and experienced dance teacher capable of independently leading exciting, challenging dance classes (warm-ups, across-the-floor work, and routines to perform).
- Must love teaching and sharing your passion for dance.
- Must be a mature, responsible, fun-loving individual.
- Must love kids and love being a positive role-model.
- Must be ready to help make ADTC a great experience for everybody, including yourself!
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance as well as organize and oversee activities of staff and dancers.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective and productive working relationships and customer service within a diverse and multicultural environment.
- Ability to interact with all age levels.

### Income Potential:

- **ADTC Summer Visiting Choreographer (Overnight Camps only):**
  - **\$200/day** for CPCs working at least two consecutive days at an ADTC overnight camp (plus full room & board and all travel compensation).
- **ADTC Summer Instructor-Counselor (Overnight & Local Day Camps):**
  - **\$850/week** for returning ICs working at least two consecutive sessions (plus full room & board and travel compensation up to \$100 total).
  - **\$800/week** for returning ICs working one session (plus full room & board and travel compensation up to \$100 total).
  - **\$750/week** for new ICs working at least 2 consecutive sessions (plus full room & board and travel compensation up to \$100 total).
  - **\$700/week** for new ICs working one session only (plus full room & board and travel compensation up to \$100 total).
- **ADTC Boot Camps, Master Classes & Private Events:**
  - **\$200/day** (approx. 4 - 5 hours/day)
- **Your Local Workshops = Your Fees (FREE marketing by ADTC when you agree to also market our camps at workshops)**

### ADTC 2011 Staffing Needs

**Year-Round Dance Boot Camps, Master Classes & Private Events (Studios throughout the US & abroad):** Our needs will be dependent on the number of dance studios requesting boot camps, master classes & private camps, and their needs in terms of dance discipline/s & location of choreographer. ADTC can only promise to extend firm job offers to willing and available choreographers on a rolling basis, when a dance boot camp warrants hiring.

**Summer Overnight Camps (destination resorts & universities throughout the US):** Our needs will be dependent on the number of registered campers in each session. We intend to maintain a counselor-camper ratio of at least 1:7. As registrations continue to come in daily through the first day of camp and beyond, it is impossible for us to know definitively how many ICs per session we will need. ADTC can only promise to extend firm job offers to willing and available applicants on a rolling basis, as soon as a session's enrollment warrants additional hires.
