## ADTC 2010 Group Airport Shuttle Info

In 2010, ADTC is pleased to offer our campers flying to camp alone the option of taking the ADTC Group Airport Shuttle from the airport to camp on Sunday of their check-in day, and back to the airport on Saturday of their check-out day.

### Airports We Service

*\*Please see the Single Rider section below for important pricing stipulations. For camps where the fee is TBD, we will notify all families registered for the shuttle ASAP. Expect the fee to be between \$50-\$100 each way.*

If your camper is arriving to a different local airport, or via bus or train to the local depot, you can call our recommended shuttle company to arrange your own transportation for your camper (email [ADTC@ASDance.com](mailto:ADTC@ASDance.com) or see your location's [Information Packet](#) for info), investigate and hire another local shuttle company, or we may be able to arrange a private chaperoned shuttle for your camper,

### ARRIVAL DAY

Each ADTC Group Shuttle will be chaperoned by at least one ADTC staff member, who will greet each camper as she arrives through security. Your daughter will just need to look for the ADTC sign and the smiling, welcoming faces!

Once everyone has arrived and collected their bags, our staff will lead the campers to the shuttle meeting point to meet our driver. In each camp location, we contract with a professional third-party shuttle company to take us to and from the airport.

## **Arrival Times on Sunday**

Campers' flights will need to arrive within the times indicated below to qualify for the group shuttle:

Campers' flights must arrive between these times, or they will not be eligible for the group shuttle. If these times do not work, we may be able to arrange a private chaperoned shuttle for your camper, or you may contact our recommended shuttle company to arrange your own transportation for her.

## **Delayed Flights:**

If a camper's flight is delayed on arrival, and the delay is less than one hour, we wait for the camper as a group. Flights that are delayed longer than one hour can be handled in one of two ways:

- 1) An ADTC staffer waits to accompany the delayed camper on a private shuttle. (This option requires the parents to pay the actual cost of the private shuttle for our staff member and the camper, minus the amount already paid for the camper to take the ADTC group shuttle) OR
- 2) Parents can authorize ADTC to arrange a shuttle for their camper directly with our contracted shuttle company, without an ADTC chaperone (This option requires the parents to pay the actual cost of the shuttle for their camper, and ADTC will refund the amount already paid for the camper to take the ADTC group shuttle)

Parents must indicate their preference for handling a delay longer than one hour on "Form 6: Authorized Release To and From" on the ADTC Group Shuttle Sign-Up page.

## **DEPARTURE DAY**

All campers taking the group shuttle to the airport for check-out will need to be fully packed and ready to leave camp bright and early, because we leave as a group in time for the first camper's flight home. Depending on the camp location and camper's flight schedules, this may be as early as 5:00 a.m.!

## **Departure Times on Saturday:**

Campers' flight departure times MUST be after 9:00 a.m. on Saturday to qualify for the group shuttle. Otherwise, we can work with you to arrange a private shuttle. We respectfully request that parents please try to find flights departing after 10:00 a.m., (11:00 a.m. from Denver and Albany) to help us avoid 5:00 a.m. shuttle departures from camp. Thanks!

### **Unaccompanied Minors Information:**

**Arrival:** For younger campers flying with an airline's Unaccompanied Minor program, the airline will require the parent to give the name of the person meeting the camper on arrival when making the minor's reservation. Unfortunately, we will be able to give the name of the specific ADTC staffer meeting each shuttle until 1-2 weeks before the shuttle date. We apologize for the inconvenience. As soon as the staff member accompanying each shuttle is finalized, we will email the staffer's name to all families registered to take the shuttle. Thanks for your patience and understanding on this point.

**Departure:** Parents must arrange with the airline for ADTC to transfer custody of the camper to the airline upon the camper's arrival to the airport. ADTC staff cannot remain at the airport with the camper after the camper checks-in with the airline.

### **Single Riders on the Group Shuttle**

Prices shown are based on a minimum of two campers taking the group shuttle per trip. If a camper registers for the group shuttle, and no other campers register to take the shuttle that day, we can handle the situation one of two ways (similar to the Delayed Flight scenario):

- 1) An ADTC staffer can accompany the camper on a private shuttle. (This option requires the parents to pay the actual cost of the private shuttle for our staff member and the camper, minus the amount already paid for the camper to take the ADTC group shuttle) OR
- 2) Parents can authorize ADTC to arrange a shuttle for their camper directly with our contracted shuttle company, without an ADTC chaperone (This option requires the parents to pay the actual cost of the shuttle for their camper, and ADTC will refund the amount already paid for the camper to take the ADTC group shuttle)

Parents must indicate their preference for handling a potential Single Rider Situation on "Form 6: Authorized Release To and From" on the ADTC Group Shuttle Sign-Up page.

We will notify families with Single Rider scenarios before the camper's arrival date, approximately 2 weeks prior. Please note that last-minute cancellations by other families may create unforeseen Single Rider situations. In this case we can apply any cancellation fee retained by us to your account.

### **Shuttle Registration:**

To register your camper for the ADTC Group Shuttle, fill out our "Form 6: Authorized Release To and From". The ADTC Group Shuttle Sign-Up page is page 3 of this form. This is the only way we can take reservations for the ADTC Group Shuttle.

### **Private ADTC-Chaperoned Shuttles:**

### **Cancellations**

Cancellations up to two weeks before the camper's arrival date to camp will incur a \$20 cancellation charge. Cancellations within two weeks of the camper's camp arrival date will be eligible for a 50% refund.
